1. Click on “Directory” from the sidebar.


2. You’ll see a list of categories appear. Simply click on something of interest to you and click on the relevant link. Let’s try clicking on “Family Support and Basic Needs” then on “Family Support.”

3. You’ll see results similar to the one that we did for the “Search feature.”

make your selections.
