

The What:

Google Classroom is a free web service developed by Google for schools and organizations that aims to simplify creating, distributing, and grading assignments.

The Why:

- Easily Integrates with Google Suite
- Free
- User-Friendly

- Recommend that you give a point value to all work to incentivize completion.
- Make sure students understand expectations of using google classroom.
